Purchase/Registration

- **What is the cost of Online TPATC?**
The course costs \$299 for ASTNA/IAFCCP members and \$425 for non-members if purchased in 2018 as this is an introductory special. For information about individual or bulk order discounts, contact the ASTNA office at 303-344-0457 or ngood@astna.org.
- **How do I purchase Online TPATC?**
You can register for the Online TPATC at www.astna.org in the Events Calendar. You must have a record in the system and that can be done by either being an ASTNA member or creating a non-member Education-Only record. Please contact the ASTNA Office for any questions about refunds.
- **What are the system requirements for accessing the course?**
Online TPATC can be accessed through any internet browser with available internet access. Chrome works the best with the Online TPATC. We will be investigating the ability to offer the course offline in the future.
- **What is included in my course registration?**
Your registration fee includes 90-day access to TPATC Online and a copy of the TPATC *Study Guide* and *Advanced Skills Guide*.
- **How long will I have access to Online TPATC?**

- **Will I receive the TPATC *Study Guide*?**

A copy of the TPATC *Study Guide* and the *Advanced Skills Guides* will be mailed to you upon registration.

- **Can I listen to lectures and/or view videos more than once?**

Lectures and videos will be available to repeat as long as you are in your 90-day window.

Skills and Course Assessment

- **How is the TPATC skills component addressed?**

At this time, ASTNA is unable to sign off on hands-on skills. You may use your programs own hands on skills in conjunction with Online TPATC to meet CAMTS and other advanced trauma requirements. ASTNA may be offering skills days in the future. We will also provide an *Advanced Skills Guide* book that outlines the skills performed during the in-person course so that you may utilize it help form your programs skills.

- **Is there a course assessment?**

Yes, there is a 50-question course assessment based on the lecture content. If you do not pass the exam on your first attempt, please contact the ASTNA Office to setup the opportunity to retest. One retest will be allowed for a total of two attempts at the exam.

- **How much time do I have to complete the assessment?**

Once you open the assessment, you will have 90 minutes to complete the 50 questions. You must complete the exam at one time and cannot leave and return to complete at a another time.

Certificate and CE

- **How long is my certificate of completion care valid?**

4 years

- **Will I receive a TPATC Provider card?**

You will receive a card that states you have completed the Online TPATC which includes didactic content and an exam to assess what you learned during the course.

- **How many hours of CE will I receive?**

You will receive 17.4 CE hours upon completion of Online TPATC.

- **Does Online TPATC meet CAMTS requirements?**

Online TPATC is approved by CAMTS to meet didactic education requirements and when augmented with your programs hands-on skills will fully meet CAMTS transport and trauma education requirements.
