In order to maintain certification, the individual must earn fifty (50) credits over the two-year recertification period. Each subsection of credits has a maximum number of points allowed toward recertification. Proof of credits towards recertification are not required with this application, but may be requested/audited by ATAP at any time during the processing of your renewal. Falsely representing recertification credits shall result in removal of certification. Credits may be earned as follows:

Two	Membership in the following nonprofit professional association preapproved by ATAP: CATAP, AETAP and APATAP (five points per year of membership per association; 10 points maximum)	5	
Three	Membership in nonprofit professional association not preapproved by ATAP (subject to review; two points per year of membership per association; 2 maximum points)	2	

Volunteer Leadership			
Type	Description	Points	Your Score
One	Volunteer leadership as a member of an ATAP Association Board or Committee per year (20 maximum points)	10	
Two	Volunteer leadership of a national or international chartered organization in related fields of human resources, law, law enforcement, psychology or security per year (5 maximum points)	5	

Publication			
Type	Description	Points	Your Score
One	Per Threat Assessment/Management related book published	10	
Two	Per Threat Assessment/Management related publication in a periodical	5	
Three	Per article or chapter published in non-peer reviewed book or periodical	2	

Education			
Type	Description	Points	Your Score
One	Attendance at an ATAP-sponsored National or Regional Conference* consisting of more than two days of instruction	20	
Two	Attendance at an ATAP-sponsored Chapter Training Event consisting of one to two days of training	15	
Three	Attendance at an ATAP Chapter Meeting lasting less than one full day	5	
Four	Attendance at a non-ATAP seminar or conference whose primary program outline is focused on threat assessment/management (5 maximum points)	5	
Five	Attendance at a non-ATAP seminar or conference related to human resources, law, law enforcement, psychology or security (3 maximum points)	3	
Six	Completion of accredited college courses in related fields of threat assessment/management. (10 points maximum)	5 points per course	

* Educational events can only be counted once in a particular category. For example: you cannot go to TMC and get 20 points and then also enter it as a conference whose primary program is TAM for an additional 5 points

Instruction			
Type	Description	Points	Your Score
One	Instruction or complete curriculum development for course work for accredited programs at a college or university in topics related to threat assessment/management. (Credits issued per class taught.)	15	
Two	Instruction or presentation at ATAP conferences or chapter events	10 points per presentation	
Three	Instruction or presentation at conferences or events in related fields of threat assessment/management (10 points maximum)	5 points per presentation	
Four	Instruction or presentation at conferences or events related to human resources, law, law enforcement, psychology or security (maximum 5 points)	5	

Expiration & Extension

A certification is considered expired on the date of expiration and there are no extensions except as provided in this document. Individuals may renew their certification up to one year after expiration without reapplying if they have obtained prior approval by the committee. This extension will only be provided if temporary duty orders are provided such as military orders, overseas TDY for an extended period or medical condition that prohibits meeting recertification requirements.
