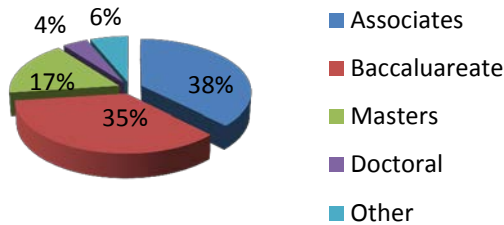

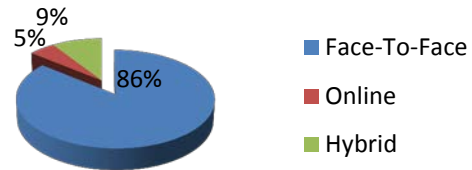

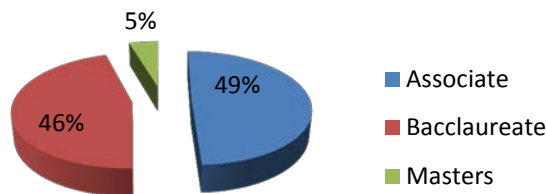

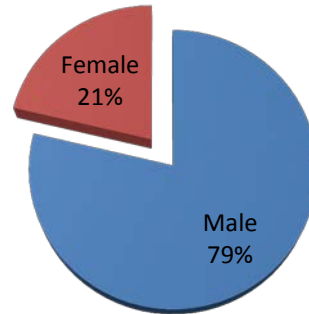

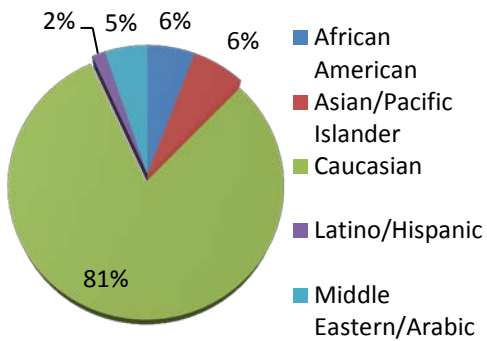
Full-Time Faculty



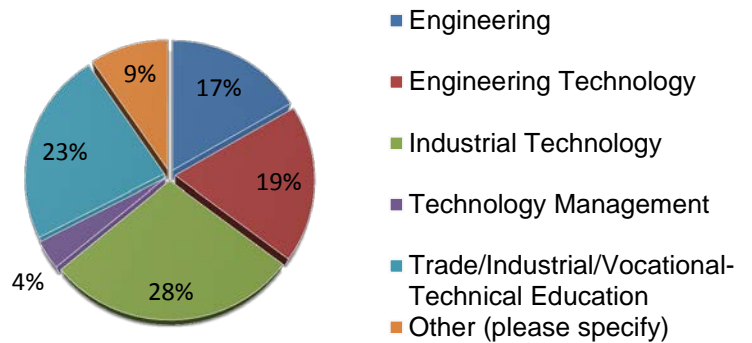
Part-Time Faculty



Faculty by Racial/Ethnic Background



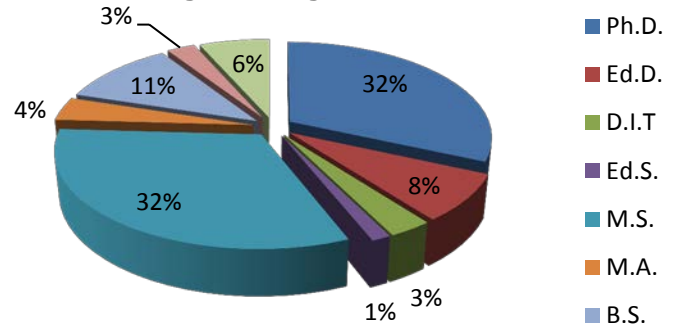

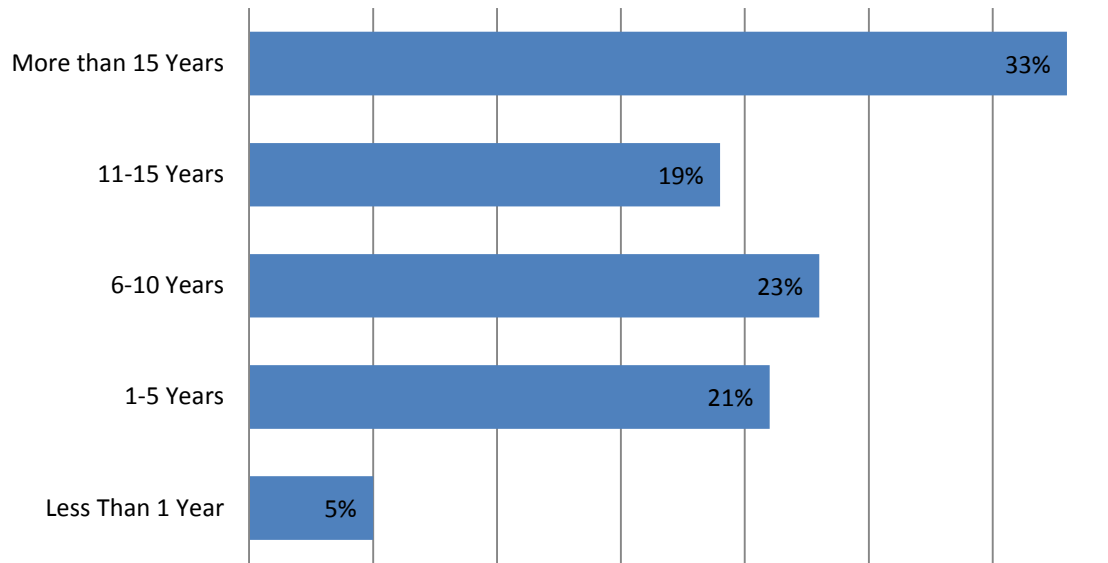
