



## Excellence for Women in Technology Award

**2020 Nomination Deadline: August 14, 2020**

**Purpose and Scope:** Recognizing women for their achievement in technology, which made an impact on society or consumers.

**Establishment and Support:** The award was established in 2011, with support from the NIAC, ATMAE Executive Board, Women in Technology, and Awards Committee. The award was revised and approved by the ATMAE Board of Directors on November 22, 2014 to include educators per the request of the ATMAE Women in Technology Division.

**The Award:** The recipient is presented a personalized plaque.

**Award Presentation:** The “ATMAE Excellence for Women in Technology, Management and Applied Engineering” Award will be presented during the 2020 ATMAE and IAJC Joint Conference scheduled October 7-9 in Louisville, Kentucky. The exact date and time to be announced. Attendance is encouraged, but not required.

**Nominations and Criteria:** To nominate an individual who is an ATMAE member or non-ATMAE member for the ATMAE Excellence for Women in Technology, Management and Applied Engineering Award:

- NOTE: An individual may nominate themselves for the award.
- The individual has worked 10+ years in education or industry.
- Submit the individual’s name, resume, cover letter, and other materials relevant to the selection criteria contained in this document. All materials (i.e., cover letter, resume, letters of support, etc.) will be submitted as PDF attachments to an email message. DO NOT paste the content of the cover letter, resume, letters of support, etc. in the text of an email message. If others are submitting supporting material, ensure they are aware of these requirements.
- The cover letter should highlight the nominee’s major accomplishments.
- **File Name Format:** XXX WITMAE YYY where XXX is the last name of the nominee, WITMAE is Women in Technology, Management and Applied Engineering and YYY is the description of the content—i.e. cover letter, resume, a letter of support, etc. If you’re not comfortable placing a space between the individual words or parts of the file name, feel free to underscore. DO NOT run the parts together. File name example: Smith WITMAE Support Letter
- **Email Subject Line Format:** For the subject line of the email containing the PDFs, use the following format: WITMAE ZZZ where ZZZ is the last name of the nominee. Email subject line example: WITMAE Smith

We ask this of all who are involved in nominating deserving individuals is to ensure every consideration is given to the nominees. Failing to comply will put deserving individuals at risk for not being given every consideration.

**Nomination Deadline:** 5:00 PM ET August 14, 2020.
