### 2026 Harriet Evelyn Wallace Scholarship Announcement

The Association for Women Geoscientists is pleased to offer the Harriet Evelyn Wallace Scholarship for 2026, with funding donated by the American Geosciences Institute (AGI). The Wallace Scholarship is a merit-based scholarship that provides support for a woman pursuing a Master's or Doctoral degree in the geosciences. It was established from a bequest by Harriet Evelyn Wallace, one of the founding members of the Geoscience Information Society (GSIS).

The Wallace Scholarship provides a one-time \$5000.00 award each year.

Application Deadline: February 1, 2026

#### Scholarship Eligibility

The applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Enrolled full-time, or accepted for full-time enrollment, in a graduate program in the geosciences.
2. Attending (or planning to attend) an accredited U.S. college or university.
3. U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
4. Identifies as a woman.
5. Minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.5 and graduate GPA of 3.0.
6. Member of at least one geoscience professional society.

#### Application Materials and Procedures

- Complete the application (form and procedures available for download <https://www.awg.org/page/ScholarshipsandAwards>). Application includes two 500-word (or less) summaries of:
  - Research interests in graduate school, how you will accomplish the research, and the impact of your research
  - Personal statement about your non-academic interests
- Submit copies of undergraduate and graduate school transcripts (unofficial are acceptable).
- Include a curriculum vitae (no more than 5 pages) (CV - not a resume)

#### Evaluation Criteria:

The Harriet Evelyn Wallace Scholarship is solely merit-based and applicants will be evaluated on their probability of successfully completing a geoscience graduate program and transitioning into the geoscience profession following graduation.
