# **Attendee Cancellation**

Students who cancel at least two weeks in advance of the first day of the Institute will receive a full refund less a \$500 cancellation fee. Students who cancel within two weeks of the first day of the Institute will receive no refund. #### Institute Cancellation

AWI reserves the right to cancel the Institute due to extraordinary circumstances, in which case a full refund of the registration tuition will be provided.

#### Attendance

Attendance at the entire Institute is required of each student to obtain the certificate. Students who do not meet attendance requirements will not be eligible to take the assessments. However, AWI recognizes that matters of personal necessity, such as using the restroom or taking an emergency telephone call, may unavoidably occur outside of scheduled breaks. To allow for such matters without unduly interfering with the learning necessary to attain the core knowledge and skills taught at the Institute, a student may be absent for up to 15 minutes during each day of the live training.

## Data Privacy/GDPR

We host events throughout the year, including our annual conference, webinars, and trainings (collectively "events"). If you are a member and register for one of our events, we will access the information in your member account to provide you with information and services associated with the event. If you are not a member and you register for one of our events, we will collect your name and contact information, which we will store in our database and use to provide you with information and services associated with the event. If you are a presenter at one of our events, we will collect information about you including your name, employer and contact information, and photograph, and we may also collect information provided by event attendees who evaluated your performance as a presenter. As an attendee, speaker, or sponsor/exhibitor, we will keep a record of your participation to provide you with post-event information including details on upcoming events you may be interested in. Your contact information may be shared with the virtual platform provider or attendee list as part of your participation in the event.
