Course Description: This course provides hands on training for practical and efficient use of the Incident Qualification System (IQS) as well as providing the information needed to navigate the Arizona State Wildland Qualification System with ease. Topics include:

- 1) Build and maintain qualification and training records in IQS and print red cards
- 2) Analyze the organizations training needs to schedule training based on agency needs
- 3) Schedule Training, complete course nominations, build rosters, print NWCG Certificates
- 4) Initiating & Certifying taskbooks and the procedures followed by the Arizona State Qualification Review Committee
- 5) Overview of the IQS and Resource Ordering and Status System (ROSS) Interface

Target Group: This course is designed for a person who is authorized to maintain wildland fire training and experience records for their agency. The student will be given an account in the Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire Management IQSweb and will be able to manage wildland training records for personnel in their agency.

Prerequisites: Students who do not have current access to IQS will be sent a username and login to go into IQS and snoop around prior to the class.
