



The Arizona Association for Home Care (AAHC) is a nonprofit 501(c)6 organization.

Eligibility

A Provider Member is a company that provides health services as defined by Arizona State Law (ARS) and is required to be licensed by the Arizona Department of Health Services (DHS) as a home health agency. Note: Medicare certification is optional.

Dues Calculation:

Dues are based on the number of Employees per Hours Worked (or Full-time Equivalent—FTE). FTE applies to all employees including employees that make visits, office staff, administrators and supervisory personnel. To compute FTE, take the sum of all hours for which employees are paid and divide it by 2,080, then round to the nearest whole number. To compute the sum of hours for contract staff paid per visit, multiply the number of visits by 1.5 and round to the nearest whole number. To figure your total FTE, add the above two figures.

Provider Membership Categories:

- Provider I: 1-25 FTE (2,080-52,000 hours)
- Provider II: 26-50 FTE (52,001-104,000 hours)
- Provider III: 51-100 FTE (104,001-208,000 hours)
- Provider IV: 101-200 FTE (208,001-416,000 hours)
- Provider V: 201 + FTE (416,001+ hours)
