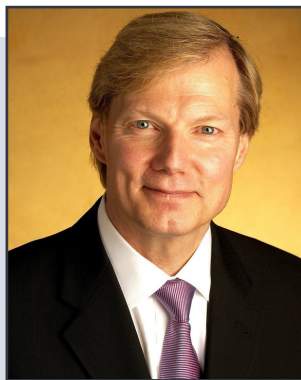
In his rightful place as an eminent authority in generation study, Chuck has taken on the generational challenges that confront nursing and all of healthcare including:
