



School Outreach Program

A series of **four** events spaced over the course of the school year to introduce local students to the water / wastewater industry, explore Arizona water-related issues, and show the students opportunities to get involved in this field as a career, thereby increasing our visibility in local schools for the express purpose to advance our profession for future generations.



1 A visit by one of our members to make a presentation and interact with the student group. The primary topics include: (1) Arizona's water / wastewater issues, (2) treatment demonstration, (3) career and educational opportunities in the water / wastewater field.




2 A tour for the students to a local operating water or wastewater treatment facility. These tours typically last from 90 to 120 minutes. Members of our committee will arrange the location and for staff at the facility to provide the tour. The school must arrange transportation for the students to the tour site.



3 Members of our committee will help students with science projects or on-going service projects of their choosing at their school or elsewhere in the community.



4 A visit for the student group to the AZ Water Annual Conference in May 2018. This event is a technical conference and manufacturer's exhibition covering all of the various aspects of the water / wastewater industry in Arizona. It typically draws about 1,500 attendees from throughout the state.
