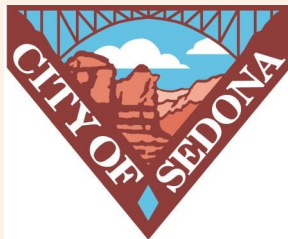


The AZ Water Association Wastewater Treatment Committee presents a technical tour and training opportunity

The Sedona WWTP is a 1.8 mgd facility owned and operated by the City of Sedona. The plant performs biological nitrogen removal, effluent filtration, and UV disinfection. As part of a recent upgrade, the City added a new secondary clarifier, aerobic digester, and positive displacement blowers with DO control. The City has also constructed two aquifer injection wells, along with 400 acres of irrigation and a 25-acre wetlands park to manage the reclaimed water produced by the facility.

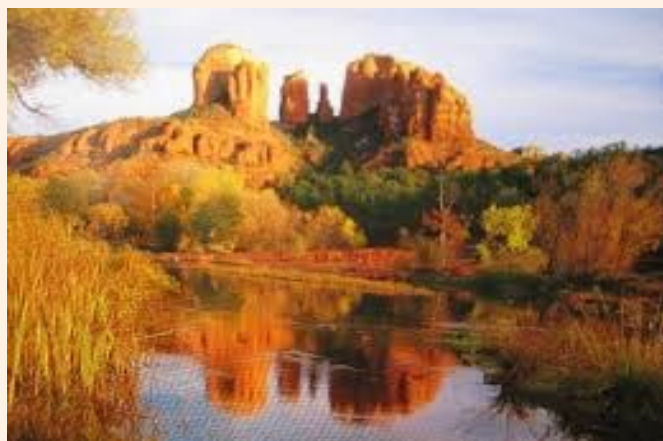
Operator math workshop
