- Innovation of Content
- Visual Appeal

Please be sure to follow all poster text and graphic requirements for judging below. *Please note, it will be the responsibility of the person submitting the application to print the poster and have it delivered to the symposium in Flagstaff.*

## **POSTER TEXT REQUIREMENTS (total of 700-800 words, no more than 1,000)**

1. Title
2. Summary – 150 words
3. Objectives – 125 words
4. Methods – 150 words
5. Results to Date – 150 words
6. Benefits to the Industry – 150 words
7. Contact – email address, phone number, affiliation/association, photo
8. Authors – 15 words (include Co-PIs)
9. Acknowledgements – 50 words (students, staff, supplier, etc.)
10. Images – Two to four photos, graphs, tables, etc.

## **POSTER GRAPHIC FILE REQUIREMENTS**

1. Photos, graphs, tables at 300 dpi or vector-based PDF with embedded fonts
2. Charts, tables and graphs must all have the same font, color and style
3. Minimum of two (2) images and not more than four (4) images
4. Simplify charts, graphs and tables so they are easy to read
5. One color headshot photo of yourself must be included
