
- Jason Bobko has been in the drinking water industry for 21 years.

Which internet browsers work best with the online portal?

Chrome or Firefox is best for accessing the online portal from a PC; Chrome, Firefox and Safari are all best for accessing the portal from a Mac.

How do I find the email address ADEO has on file for me?

Your email on file with ADEQ can be found by searching the Operator Database | Search Now >

What if my email address is listed incorrectly or I can no longer access the address?

What do I do if the portal asks for a password after I enter my email address to register?

First, check the Operator Database to confirm you are entering the correct email address on file | Search Now >

What if I don't receive a verification code?

You must click "SEND ME THE CODE." After the verification code screen appears, you should receive the email within 30 seconds. If you don't see it, check your "Spam" email folder. If it's there, you may need to adjust your spam filter settings to allow our system emails into your inbox.

Why aren't my professional development hours (PDHs) applicable to the certificate(s) I am renewing?


All PDHs must be earned during your three-year certificate window. Confirm that the start and end dates of the training are within the three-year window (e.g., If your expiration date is Nov. 30, 2020 your three-year window is Nov. 30, 2017 to Nov. 30, 2020).

Will I get a receipt for paying for my certification online?

Yes. The Arizona Department of Administration manages the payment site (J-Billing), which generates an email with a receipt attached upon payment. This receipt is sent to the email address entered on the payment screen (not necessarily the email on file in the Operator Database).



ADEQ's Operator Certification Program establishes guidelines to ensure that only certified operators make decisions about process control or system integrity that affects public health. The program establishes minimum standards for certification and recertification of the operators of drinking water and wastewater systems.

Who Is An Operator?

A certified operator is an individual who holds a current certificate issued by ADEQ in the field of water or wastewater treatment, water distribution, or wastewater collection. All water and wastewater facilities require an operator in direct charge who is certified for the class of the facility at or above the grade of the facility. Facility owners need to ensure that all current operators working in their facility are on file with ADEQ.

Who Must Be Certified?

- Grade 3 & 4 facilities require an on-site operator.
- Grade 1 & 2 facilities require an on-site representative.
- Grade 1 distribution facilities, serving fewer than 100 people, do not need an onsite representative.

How Do I Become A Certified Operator?

To become a certified operator, you will need to take the Operator Certification Examination. No work experience at a water or wastewater facility is required to complete an operator certification exam in Arizona.

Examination Requirements:

- . To sit for a Grade 1 exam, you must have a high school diploma or GED.
- · Operators must hold the lower-grade-level certificate for one full year (365 days from the effective date), prior to sitting for the next grade level. To check the

How to register for an Operator Certification Exam

Step 1: Decide which Operator Certification you will test for – Grade 1 exams require a high school diploma or GED. Contact ADEQ's Operator Certification Program for approval to skip one grade if you have less than one year with a previous grade.

Step 2: Review the GateWay exam dates & locations. Available Exam Dates: All Locations tab.

Step 3: Pre-order your exam using the NEW Purplepass System – You no longer need to create a Maricopa Student Account. (Purplepass only accepts credit cards as payment). See 'Exam Information' tab for details.

Step 4: After passing your exam – Apply for your new or upgraded certificate with ADEQ. As of July 1, 2016, ADEQ requires everyone to complete a **New Certificate Application**, provide a converted results, and pay a \$65 for
