From Test Plan 16.0v2:
2.1.11 Initiates Confirmed Requests The IUT initiates any BACnet confirmed requests.
135.1-2013 - 13.9.1 - APDU Retry and Timeout
Test Conditionality Must be executed. Test Directives
Testing Hints .
From 135.1-2013 – 13.9.1: "The IUT shall be configured with a non-zero value in its Number_Of_APDU_Retries property"
Problem: For an IUT that does not perform retries (Number_Of_APDU_Retries is fixed at 0) but Initiates Confirmed Requests, there is no way to meet the configuration requirements for this test yet it must be executed.
Of note: The standard allows for the case of a device that "does not perform retries" (see clause 12.11.29).
Question: Can test 13.9.1 be skipped if the device does not perform retries?
RESPONSE:
Yes. The Test Package will be updated to accommodate devices which do not perform retries
