Effective Date: July 1, 2018
HB 605	Drug Safety	Geller	Drug Safety: Requires warning label meeting certain requirements to be applied to specified opioids dispensed by pharmacists or practitioners; requires pharmacies to offer for sale prescription lock boxes; authorizes DOH to develop & distribute pamphlet.
