*Effective September 22, 2022**

BCA Covid-19 Protocols are suspended until further notice.

- All BCA participants are welcome to wear face masks at BCA events to protect the health & safety of self and other participants.
 - BCA Board of Directors will continue to review BCA COVID-19 Protocols each month until it is satisfied that prior protocols¹ can be suspended permanently.

¹ Prior BCA COVID-19 Protocols, as adopted June 24, 2022 and suspended September 22, 2022 are listed below for on-going reference:

The intent of these protocols is to protect BCA members and those we interact with

- Protective masks are encouraged to be worn by participants except when eating or drinking*
- Health and Safety Protocols will be contained in the event invitation
- Access to the event is by invitation only and will be controlled at the entry door
- Hand sanitizing stations will be provided
- Clean washroom facilities will be provided
- Seating will be available for each participant
- If food or drink is served, participants are to be reminded to wash or sanitize their hands before touching self-serve food, drink or other items
- Direct Contact A/V equipment to be sanitized before individual use
- All participants must comply with these requirements, and with other measures, guidance or directions from BCA which are intended to protect the health and safety of participants
- Health and Safety Signage containing these protocols will be installed at the event
- Event organizers must also comply with the health and safety protocols of the Event venue
- BCA Board of Directors reserves the right to set higher standards than local Public Health Orders
- These protocols will be reviewed at each Board of Directors meeting for the foreseeable future
