She subsequently specialised in nuclear medicine, obtaining a CCT in 2006, following which she was appointed to her current post.

Her special interests include hybrid imaging (particularly in patients with neuroendocrine tumours), and radionuclide therapy. She is the nuclear medicine lead for the National Amyloidosis Centre at the Royal Free.
