Talk title: Learning from discrepancies in nuclear medicine

Dr Jonathan Smith graduated from Manchester Medical School in 1995 and did his MRCP in Manchester before crossing the Pennines to train in Radiology in Leeds. He became a consultant in Leeds THT in 2007 and has developed an interest in imaging and treating cancer. As well as plain film, CT and MRI reporting he is part of the PET CT and Interventional Oncology teams which use brachytherapy to treat prostate cancer and microwave, IRE and cryotherapy to treat lung, liver and kidney cancers. He was audit lead for 5 years after publishing his own mistakes at ECR and has since taken up the post of Chair of the RCR Radiology Events and Learning Panel. His interest in how doctors learn from their mistakes has led to several publications and 7 National Errors courses in Leeds, Birmingham and London.
