

Invited Speaker Guidelines.

Oral Abstract Presenters

Authors of accepted oral abstracts grant permission to BNMS to use their presentations on the BNMS website. Accepted oral abstract presentations should be 9 minutes long with 2 minutes for questions.

YIP entries should be 20 minutes long, 15 minutes in length with 5 minutes for questions.

Please consult the programme for details of the length of your talk and timings.

General PowerPoint Guidelines

- All presenters must disclose any conflict of interest. Financial disclosure includes any commercial funding you receive from a company whose product(s) you are discussing.
- If you are referencing work within your presentation previously published by another author, be sure to include a complete citation at the bottom of the appropriate page.
- Exclude any information from your presentation that may compromise or violate patient confidentiality.

Uploading your presentation

We request that you bring your final presentation on a USB drive. A back up disc is also recommended.

General PowerPoint Guidelines
