What is World Water Week?

World Water Week is one of the pre-eminent water events in the world. It is held annually in Stockholm, Sweden and hosted by the Stockholm International Water Institute. This event has been held every year since 1991 and is designed to help develop solutions to the biggest water-related challenges facing the world. World Water Week hosts sessions on a broad range of topics convened by global organisations.
