Criteria & Guidelines

Purpose:

The purpose of the Broadcasters' Education Fund ("Fund") is to assist Louisiana high school & university mass communication students further their knowledge of the broadcast industry.

Standard:

Principal and interest of the Fund may be distributed (i) to pay expenses associated with the annual Louisiana Association of Broadcasters ("LAB") Student Career Workshop, (ii) to send students to broadcast-related conventions and meetings and (iii) to support other projects to further the broadcast education of Louisiana students as may be determined by the LAB Board of Directors from time to time.

Process:

Principal and interest of the Fund will be distributed in a manner determined by the LAB Board of Directors.

Documentation:

The LAB shall maintain adequate records of all expenditures from the Fund, including without limitation the following:

1. The purpose for which the funds were used;
2. A full description of the applicable event or assistance;
3. The amount distributed and name, address and manner of selection of each recipient.

Overarching Principle:

All distributions from the Fund shall be made in furtherance of its charitable purposes and consistent with the qualified tax-exempt purposes of the Baton Rouge Area Foundation.
