CAROLINA PRESERVE AT AMBERLY NAMED COMMUNITY OF EXCELLENCE

International HOA Organization Honors 5 NC Communities

CARY, NC – Carolina Preserve by Del Webb at Amberly has been chosen as a Community Associations Institute (CAI) “Community of Excellence.”

The North Carolina chapter of this international organization, dedicated to building better communities, presented this award to five community associations Friday, March 22 in Charlotte. This honor recognizes the work of volunteer leaders and management professionals whose contributions exemplify excellence in self-government, leadership and stewardship in 2018.

Carolina Preserve is a 55+ development of 1,360 single family homes in Cary. Judges were particularly struck by the model strategic planning, governance and planned activities from the community’s HOA.

Community associations, commonly referred to as homeowner associations (HOAs), are self-governing bodies whose success is dependent on the commitment and competence of their elected leaders. The Carolina Preserve at Amberly has exemplified community association excellence.
