

## **TRAINEE SCIENTIFIC MEETING TRAVEL GRANT 2019**

### **APPLICATION DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

#### **DESCRIPTION**

The **Trainee Scientific Meeting Travel Grant** is awarded to CPS Trainee Members to support the cost of travel to the 2019 Scientific Meeting in Toronto, Ontario, April 2-5, 2019.

#### **AWARD**

The grant consists of:

- A \$500 honorarium
- One complimentary Awards Gala ticket to the annual reception and dinner on Thursday April 4, where the awards will be announced

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Applicants must be current trainee members of the Canadian Pain Society ([click here to join CPS today](#)).
- Applicants at all academic levels will be considered, including undergraduate and graduate students, post-doctoral fellows, residents and interns.
- Applicants must be studying in the field of pain.
- Applicants receiving an award must commit to register for and attend the full 3 day Scientific Meeting from April 2-5, 2019.
- Priority will be given to trainees participating in symposia and/or as poster presenters
- Additional consideration will be given to trainees with no other funding and those who have not attended a CPS Scientific Meeting.
- **Note: Recipients of 2018 Trainee Travel Grants are not eligible for 2019.**
