AWARD

The award consists of:

- Economy class travel to the CPS Annual Scientific Meeting (up to \$1000.00)
- Taxi fare and incidentals (up to \$100.00)
- Two (2) nights' accommodation at the Scientific Meeting hotel
- \$1000.00 honorarium
- Plaque
- Complimentary three-day (3) Scientific Meeting registration
- Complimentary ticket to the Gala dinner, where the award will be presented

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

- Candidates must be current members in good standing with the Canadian Pain Society
- A letter of nomination signed by three CPS regular members that clearly summarizes the nominee's contributions to pain research and/or management (e.g., clinical responsibilities)
- CV of the nominee
