DESCRIPTION

The **Outstanding Pain Mentorship Award** will be presented annually at the CPS Annual Scientific Meeting to a researcher and/or clinician who consistently exemplifies outstanding mentorship in the training of future pain researchers and/or clinicians. The selection will be made by a committee formed by the Canadian Pain Society.

AWARD

The award will consist of:

- \$1000.00 honorarium
- Plaque
- Complimentary three-day (3) Scientific Meeting registration (May 19-22, 2020 in Calgary)
- Complimentary ticket to the Gala dinner, where the award will be presented

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

- Candidates must be nominated by at least 1 colleague or current/former trainee
- The person(s) nominating and the nominee must be current members in good standing with the Canadian Pain Society
- Nomination letter (max 2 pages) describing the mentorship qualities of the candidate
- Nominee's curriculum vitae

All documents must be combined and uploaded into one PDF file. Files cannot exceed 30 MB.
