Winner announcements occur during the annual Catholic Media Conference each June, appear in *The Catholic Journalist* with judge comments, and are available on the CPA website post CMC.

Each Publication and Freelance member may submit one FREE entry.

### **Entry Divisions Reorganized and Expanded to Seven**

The Awards Committee is working to make it easier for members to find their favorite categories among the hundreds of possible entries. It reorganized the program from four divisions to seven including a new division for communication departments and organizations.

The All Member entries are now in the Digital and Business divisions. All General and Individual Excellence categories are now in the Excellence division. The new Communication division is for non-news content.

# Categories & Descriptions

#### **N01: BEST FRONT PAGE**

Judging will be based on typography, headline weight, compelling use of graphics and the degree to which the layout draws the eye over the entire page.

For tabloids that quarter-fold, the combination of a folded cover and the actual page one will be considered.

An entry consists of one PDF file containing the front pages only from any THREE consecutive issues. Only one entry per publication is permitted.

N01a: Broadsheet (approximately 17 by 22 inches) N01b: Tabloid (approximately 11 by 17 inches)

#### NO2: BEST NEWS WRITING ON A LOCAL OR REGIONAL EVENT

Entries are from straight news writing on a subject or topic originating primarily in the geographical area where the newspaper is published. Can be a single story or series, in one issue or several, and may include sidebars. Judges will not consider accompanying photographs, charts or illustrations.



Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file of the page(s) on which the article was published.

### N02a: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

### N02b: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.

### N02c: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

### N02d: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publications that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.

#### NO3: BEST NEWS WRITING ON A NATIONAL OR INTERNATIONAL EVENT

1

Entries are from straight news writing on a subject or event of national impact originating outside the geographical area where the newspaper is published. The entry may include coverage of local aspects of the subject or event. Can be a single story or series, in one or several issues, and may include sidebars. Judges will not consider accompanying photographs, charts or illustrations.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file of the page(s) on which the article was published.

N03a: National event, diocesan newspaper N03b: National event, national newspaper or wire service

N03c: International event, diocesan newspaper N03d: International event, national newspaper or wire service

### NO4: BEST INVESTIGATIVE OR ANALYSIS NEWS WRITING

1

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file of the page(s) on which the article or series was published.

N04a: BEST INVESTIGATIVE NEWS WRITING - Diocesan newspaper

NO4b: BEST INVESTIGATIVE NEWS WRITING - National newspaper or wire service

Investigative writing focuses on the initiative of the newspaper to uncover the facts of an event or situation that are otherwise unknown. Can be a series or a single article, and may include sidebars. Judges will not consider accompanying photographs, charts or illustrations.



N04c: BEST ANALYSIS/BACKGROUND/ROUND-UP NEWS WRITING: The Gerard E. Sherry Award -

N04d: BEST ANALYSIS/BACKGROUND/ROUND-UP NEWS WRITING: The Gerard E. Sherry Award -

National newspaper or wire service

Analysis writing focuses on how well the paper informs or interprets an event or situation that is controversial, confusing or misunderstood. Can be a series or a single article, and may include sidebars. Judges will not consider accompanying photographs, charts or illustrations.

# N05: BEST IN-DEPTH NEWS/SPECIAL REPORTING

1

In-depth news and special reporting focus on the initiative of the newspaper to present facts of an event or situation of importance that may be otherwise unknown to the reader. The category recognizes reporting, through one's own initiative and work, which will be judged on news value, evidence of research, and quality of reporting, writing and local focus. Entire story must have been published in one issue. Related stories, graphics, sidebars photos or videos published in the same article will be considered with the entry.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file of the page(s) on which the article was published. You may also submit a URL if your content is available online.

N05a: Diocesan newspaper

N05b: National newspaper or wire service

#### N06: BEST EDITORIAL ON A LOCAL ISSUE

An editorial is an article giving the viewpoint of the publication, editor, or staff on a subject about which different opinions can be held. The editorial may be signed or unsigned but must be written by a member of the newspaper's staff on an issue originating primarily in the geographical area where the newspaper is published. Emphasis will be on the persuasive quality of the editorial, rather than simple commentary.

An entry consists of one PDF file of the page(s) on which the editorial was published.

#### N06a: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

### N06b: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.

### N06c: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

## N06d: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publications that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.



#### NO7: BEST EDITORIAL ON A NATIONAL OR INTERNATIONAL ISSUE

An editorial is an article giving the viewpoint of the publication, editor, or staff on a subject about which different opinions can be held. The editorial may be signed or unsigned but must be written by a member of the newspaper's staff on an issue originating outside the geographical area where the newspaper is published. Emphasis will be on the persuasive quality of the editorial, rather than simple commentary.

An entry consists of one PDF file of the page(s) on which the editorial was published.

### N07a: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

### N07b: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publication that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.

### N07c: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publication that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

### N07d: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

#### **N08: BEST EDITORIAL PAGE OR SECTION**

Judging will focus on the content of page(s) as well as their layout, variety and overall effect.

An entry consists of one PDF files of the editorial page or section from THREE consecutive issues. One entry is permitted per publication.

N08a: Diocesan newspaper N08b: National newspaper

#### N09: BEST FEATURE WRITING

These entries are stories that cover a group, trend or event of general interest, not "hard" or breaking news. Story should exhibit thorough reporting, but should be distinguished by the quality of its writing, its accessibility, and its human interest value. Editorials, book and movie reviews, personality profiles, background articles and news analyses may not be submitted in this category. Judges will not consider accompanying photographs, charts or illustrations.

#### **N10: BEST PERSONALITY PROFILE**

1

Entries in this category should answer two questions: (1) Who is this person? and (2) Why does he/she make a difference? Stories should have an eye for atmosphere and significant personal details, as well as stated beliefs and accomplishments. Judges will consider the quality of writing and ability to convey through words a sense of the whole person.

Publisher and Freelance members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file of the page(s) on which the article was published.

#### N10a: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publication that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

#### N10b: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publication that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.

### N10c: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

### **N11: BEST REGULAR COLUMN**

An entry consists of THREE different articles by one or more authors. For an entry written by multiple authors to be considered it must be a column of the same name, written from time to time by different authors. Judges will focus on the overall effectiveness of the columns submitted.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. A column may be entered in one subcategory category only. An entry consists of one PDF file of the page(s) on which THREE columns were published.

#### N12: BEST REPORTING ON SPECIAL AGE GROUP

Coverage should be of what member of the age group are doing, not simply of events. May be a single article, a series (maximum three clips, please), pictures, or even a special section.

N12a: Children and teens younger than 18 N12c: Senior citize

### **N13: BEST PHOTO STORY**

1

A photo story is a cohesive group of select images that by themselves, with little added text, tell a story. The photo story should include opening and closing shots, with each picture moving the story along for the viewer. Text and photo layout/design is secondary and will be judged as such.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the pages on which the photos were published.

#### N14: BEST PHOTOGRAPH

Photos may be black and white or color. Digitally or otherwise manipulated images may be submitted only in category N14e and only if they were identified as such when published.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the page on which the photo was published and a second page containing an image of the photo by itself.

#### **N15a: BEST MULTIPLE PICTURE PACKAGE**

A multiple picture package is two or more photographs covering the same event or topic. A picture package is a group of related photos that do not tell a complete story and are almost always accompanied by text.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the pages on which the photos were published.

N15a: News N15c: Sports

N15b: Feature N15d: Share the Journey [NEW]

#### N16: BEST USE OF ART OR GRAPHICS

Judges will consider the quality of the art as well as its ability to help readers better understand the news article. Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file of the page(s) on

which the artwork or graphic and accompanying story was published.

#### N16a: Best use of art or graphics

Graphics developed by the newspaper's staff or commissioned from a freelance artist specifically for the newspaper to help explain a news or analysis story.

### N16b: Best original illustration

Artwork developed by the publication's staff or commissioned from a freelance artist specifically for the newspaper to illustrate a story or theme.

### N16c: Best chart or information graphic

A chart, graph or other infographic developed by the newspaper's staff or commissioned from a freelance artist specifically for the newspaper to help explain a news or analysis story.

#### **N18: BEST HEADLINE**

Headline writing is both a skill and an art. A good headline sells the story, provoking the reader to stop and read it. Each word is important; there is no padding. Verbs are snappy, the full headline clear and precise.

An entry consists of one PDF file containing the page(s) on which the headline and complete story were published. You may also post a URL if the content is available online. Blog titles are not eligible for this category.

### N19: BEST REGULAR SUPPLEMENT OR SPECIAL ISSUE



Items entered in any N19 subcategory may not be entered into N20. Please enter seasonal issues into N22. Judges will consider front page design, interior page layouts, and the extent to which editorial content creatively and thoroughly addresses the theme(s) of the supplement. May or may not include advertising content.

An entry consists of one HARD COPY of the supplement or issue sent to the CPA office. Each entrant must submit a PDF copy of one page for possible use during the Catholic Press Awards Banquet.

# N19a: Best regular special supplement

A regular special supplement is planned by the paper (i.e., a "back to school" supplement that runs annually).



# N19b: Best one-time special issue

A one-time special supplement is for an event that will not occur again or will not occur again for a long time (i.e., the election of Pope Francis or Pope Francis' visit to the U.S.).

### N19c: Best special supplement on the bishop's transition

This supplement focuses exclusively on a bishop's transition, including new local ordinary, new auxiliary, or retirement.

### **N21: BEST SPORTS JOURNALISM**

An article focusing on sports or athletes. Photos should be submitted in category N14f and will not be considered here.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file of the page(s) containing the published article.

N21a: Sports news

N21b: Sports feature or column

#### **N22: BEST SEASONAL ISSUE**

Entries can be made for either liturgical season (Christmas, Lent, Easter) or secular holiday (Fourth of July, Mother's Day, etc.). Judges will consider depth of content that relates to the season, cover layout and interior page design.

An entry consists of one HARD COPY of the issue sent to the CPA office. Each entrant must submit a PDF copy of one page for possible use during the Catholic Press Awards Banquet.

### N23: BEST REPORTING OF THE CELEBRATION OF A SACRAMENT

This category is an article about one of the seven sacraments: baptism, confirmation, Eucharist, penance or reconciliation, anointing the sick, holy orders and matrimony. Judges will consider the reporter's creativity and ability to tell a compelling story, as well as photographs, artwork or videos that accompany the article.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing page(s) on which the article was published. You may also submit a URL if your content is available online.

## N23a: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

## N23b: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.

## N23c: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

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### N23d: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publications that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25.001 or more.

#### N24: BEST COVERAGE OF RELIGIOUS LIBERTY ISSUES

This category awards in-depth coverage of religious liberty issues via articles, columns, special sections, or editorials. If a publication does not have THREE items to submit in this category, it may enter that item in another category (for example, best editorial, interview, column, profile, etc.). Judges will consider the writer's creativity and ability to tell a compelling story. Judges will also consider photographs, artwork or videos that accompany the items.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the pages on which THREE items (article, column, and/or editorial) that were published concerning religious liberty. You may also submit a list of URLs if your content is available online.

# N28: BEST REPORTING ON VOCATIONS TO PRIESTHOOD, RELIGIOUS LIFE OR DIACONATE

This award is for a one-shot section, a feature, series, or personality profile of a religious man or woman, deacon, priest, bishop, or cardinal. Judges will consider the writer's creativity and ability to tell a compelling story. Judges will also consider photographs, artwork or videos that accompany entries.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing page(s) on which the material was published. You may also submit a URL if your content is available online.

### N28a: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25.000 or less.

#### N28b: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.

### N28c: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

### N28d: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publications that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.

N28e: National newspaper or wire service

### **N29: BEST COVERAGE OF IMMIGRATION**

This category awards in-depth coverage of this issue via articles, columns, special sections, or editorials. If a publication does not have THREE items to submit in this category, it may enter an item in another category (for

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example, best editorial, interview, column, profile, etc.). Judges will consider the writer's creativity and ability to tell a compelling story. Judges will also consider photographs, artwork or videos that accompany the items.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the pages on which THREE items (article, column, and/or editorial) that were published concerning immigration. You may also submit a list of URLs if your content is available online.

#### N30: BEST REGULAR COLUMN BY A BISHOP OR ARCHBISHOP

Judges will consider THREE columns written by the same bishop or archbishop.

An entry consists of one PDF file of the page(s) on which THREE different columns were published.

#### N34: BEST EXPLANATION OF THE CHURCH'S POSITION ON MARRIAGE

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This category awards in-depth coverage of the Catholic Church's teaching on the sacrament of marriage via articles, columns, special sections, or editorials. If a publication does not have THREE items to submit in this category, it may enter an item in another category (for example, best editorial, interview, column, profile, etc.). Judges will consider the writer's creativity and ability to tell a compelling story. Judges will also consider photographs, artwork or videos that accompany the items.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the pages on which THREE items (article, column, and/or editorial) that were published concerning this topic. You may also submit a list of URLs if your content is available online.

## **N35: BEST COVERAGE OF LOCAL POLITICS**

[UPDATED]



This category awards in-depth coverage of local politics via articles, columns, special sections, or editorials. If a publication does not have THREE items to submit in this category, it may enter that item in another category (for example, best editorial, news writing, column, etc.). Judges will consider the writer's creativity and ability to tell a compelling story. Judges will also consider photographs, artwork or videos that accompany the items.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the pages on which THREE items (article, column, and/or editorial) that were published concerning local politics. You may also submit a list of URLs if your content is available online.

# N40: BEST REDESIGN



This category honors the redesign of a newspaper. Judging will focus on front page design, interior page layouts, graphic elements, readability, and organization of content.

An entry consists of one HARD COPY of the material to be judged. Please submit two to four samples of the redesigned publication and one sample of the "before" version of the newspaper. Include labels to indicate the "before" and "after" designs. Each entrant must submit a PDF file for possible use during the Catholic Press Awards Banquet. A letter may be submitted to explain the redesign process and the staff work necessary to complete it.



## N45: BEST COVERAGE OF THE PAPAL TRIPS OVERSEAS [NEW]

This category is for coverage of Pope Francis' overseas trips originating with the newspaper. If a publication does not have THREE articles to submit in this category, it may enter an item in another category (i.e., best editorial, interview, column, profile, etc.). Judges will consider the writer's creativity and ability to tell a compelling story. They will also consider photographs, artwork or videos that accompany the articles.

Publisher and Freelance members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the pages on which THREE items (article, column, and/or editorial) on the papal trips were published. You may also submit a list of URLs if your content is available online.

### N46: BEST COVERAGE OF VIOLENCE IN OUR COMMUNITIES

This category is for in-depth coverage of escalating violence in our communities. If a publication does not have THREE articles to submit in this category, it may enter an item in another category (i.e., best editorial, interview, column, profile, etc.). Judges will consider the writer's creativity and ability to tell a compelling story. They will also consider photographs, artwork or videos that accompany the articles.

Publisher and Freelance members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the pages on which THREE items (article, column, and/or editorial) were published. You may also submit a list of URLs if your content is available online.

N46a: Diocesan newspaper

N46b: National newspaper or wire service

### N48: BEST COVERAGE OF PRO-LIFE ISSUES

This category is for in-depth coverage of pro-life issues. If a publication does not have THREE items to submit in this category, it may enter an item in another category (i.e., best editorial, interview, column, profile, etc.). Judges will consider the writer's creativity and ability to tell a compelling story. They will also consider photographs, artwork or videos that accompany the items.

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Publisher and Freelance members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the pages on which THREE items (article, column and/or editorial) were published. You may also submit a list of URLs if your content is available online.

### N48a: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

### N48b: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.

### N48c: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

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### N48d: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publications that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.

N48e: National newspaper or wire service

#### N50: BEST COVERAGE OF ECUMENICAL AND INTERFAITH ISSUES

This category is for original content about ecumenical and/or interfaith issues (mix and match as needed). If a publication does not have THREE items to submit in this category, it may enter an item in another category (i.e., best editorial, interview, column, profile, etc.). Judges will consider the writer's creativity and ability to tell a compelling story. They will also consider photographs, artwork or videos that accompany the items.

Publisher and Freelance members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the pages on which THREE items (article, column and/or editorial) were published. You may also submit a list of URLs if your content is available online.

N50a: Diocesan Newspaper

N50b: National newspaper or wire service

#### N53: BEST LAYOUT OF ARTICLE OR COLUMN

This category recognizes the best use of graphics, text and/or photography in a single article or column.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the page(s) on which the material was published.

### N53a: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

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### N53b: Weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publications that publish 40 or more issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.

#### N53c: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,000 or less

This subcategory is for publications that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25,000 or less.

#### N53d: Non-weekly diocesan newspaper, circulation 25,001 or more

This subcategory is for publications that publish 39 or fewer issues per year and have a circulation of 25,001 or more.

N53e: National newspaper or wire service



#### **N54: BEST REPORTING OF SOCIAL JUSTICE ISSUES**

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This category is for an article or column about one of the seven themes of Catholic social teaching (based on USCCB: http://www.usccb.org/beliefs-and-teachings/what-we-believe/catholic-social-teaching/seven-themes-of-catholic-social-teaching.cfm).

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the page(s) on which the material was published. You may also submit a URL if your content is available online.

N54a: Life and dignity of the human person

N54b: Call to family, community and

participation

N54c: Rights and responsibilities

N54d: Option for the poor and vulnerable

N54e: Dignity and rights of the workers

N54f: Solidarity

N54g: Care for God's creation

#### **N55: BEST STORY AND PHOTO PACKAGE**

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This award is for an article or feature on any topic consisting of both image(s) and written content together. Judges will consider creativity and ability to tell a compelling story, as well as the overall impact of the photo and story together as one piece.

Publisher and Freelance Members may enter this category. An entry consists of one PDF file containing the pages on which the story and photo package were published.



# **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

The Catholic Press Awards is a recognition program for CPA members. The following eligibility requirements apply.

- 1. Submitters must be a CPA Publisher Member or Freelance Member in good standing. Member dues must be paid by March 31, 2018 to receive an award. **No refunds** offered after judging.
- 2. Entries must be the original work of a publication or freelancer. Include bylines/credits on all submissions. Plagiarized or incorrectly credited entries are grounds for disqualification.
- 3. Publisher Members may submit the work of any employee or freelancer. The author/creator need not be a Staff Member or Freelance Member.
- 4. Freelance Members may only enter designated categories marked with a pen symbol.  $\checkmark$ 
  - Your work must appear in the print edition of, on the website of, or in promotion of a Publisher Member.
  - **To avoid duplicate entries,** we ask Freelance Members to consult with the publication that printed the material before submitting it. Please confirm that the publication is not submitting the same work in the same category as you.
- 5. Only entries published in calendar year 2017 are accepted.

### **REASONS FOR DISQUALIFICATION**

The following are common reasons why entries are disqualified from competition.

- **Too few submissions in a single category**: Every category requires at least two submissions, by different entrants, to qualify for evaluation. <u>Submissions not evaluated receive refunds.</u>
- Entry does not meet submission requirements: Entries must be submitted properly and include all required components to be evaluated by the judges. Please check the category descriptions to make sure your entries are correct. Be sure that hard copy submissions are postmarked by the deadline and labelled correctly. Disqualified entries are not eligible for a refund.

### **JUDGING**

Faculty members from the Journalism Schools of Northwestern, Spring Hill College and DePaul University, along with select professionals familiar with the Catholic Press, judge the entries.

#### **CREATE A PUBLICATION PROFILE FIRST**

For simplicity's sake, we recommend creating **one PROFILE account** for your publication.

- Returning Entrants: you can use the same login information you used last year
- **New Entrants**: click "Enter the Catholic Press Awards" on the homepage and follow prompts to create a username and password for your account
- **Publisher Members:** please enter your publication name in the "Organization Name" field instead of your company name (i.e., The Catholic Journalist instead of The Catholic Press Association)

#### **CREATING A NEW SUBMISSION**

- 1. Once logged into your Profile account, click "MAKE ANOTHER APPLICATION" then "ENTER CATHOLIC PRESS AWARDS" You will be prompted to review your past submissions or to begin a new submission.
- 2. Select, "CLICK HERE TO BEGIN A NEW SUBMISSION", fill out the form as prompted and click "SAVE AND NEXT" to continue. You can return to the previous form at any time.
  - a. All entries are marked "Incomplete" until paid.
- 3. Options after making submissions:
  - a. <u>Save your work</u>: Click "SAVE" to save your work and leave the form. You may return and <u>edit it</u> at any time, until you pay for it, by clicking on "MY APPLICATIONS" and clicking "EDIT".
  - b. Prepare to Pay: Click "ADD TO CART" to move your saved submission to your cart.
    - i. You may return and edit them by clicking "MAKE CHANGES" prior to paying.
    - ii. You can also remove it from your cart.
    - iii. Click "CHECKOUT" to pay

- Provide clean material with no marks or highlighting on the submission
- Label your hard copy materials for easy identification (See LABELLING ENTRIES)
- If two sets of material are required, please clip together each set and affix a label to each set
- Hard copies need to be <u>postmarked</u> by February 4 and <u>received</u> by February 9 to be considered

#### **LABELLING ENTRIES**

Please label all hard copy submissions so that judges can identify them. To label your entries:

• From your profile, click "My Applications." You have the option of printing the submission forms from you completed entries. Click "Print" next to form and affix print out to your hard copy entries. Be sure to print two forms if two hard copy entries are required.

 Print the labels on the last page of the packet. Fill out all information, cut out label, and affix label to each set of hard copy submission.

Be sure to affix label to every set of hard copies. Hard copy entries that arrive without labels may be disqualified.
