

GORDON F. HENDERSON AWARD RECIPIENTS

The Gordon F. Henderson Award is presented to a lawyer (including a retired lawyer, a judge, a former judge, or a paralegal) who has made a significant contribution to the welfare of the community by performing charitable services on behalf of the community. In recognition of the recipient's great dedication and high ideals in service to the community, a \$1,000 donation will be made by the CCLA, on the recipient's behalf, to a charity of the recipient's choice. The award will be given only to a member or former member of the County of Carleton Law Association.

In the first two years that this award was handed out, it was known as the Citizen of the Year Award and until 1999, was delivered at the Law Day dinner.
