

Child Protection Scheduling Protocol: First Nation, Inuit & Métis (FNIM) Cases

Please be advised that the CYFSA Subcommittee is implementing a new First Nations, Inuit and Métis (FNIM) scheduling protocol.

Commencing in June, there will be an effort to schedule FNIM family cases to Tuesdays in child protection court. This is an effort to maximize resources of service provider agencies who may be having support persons attend court to assist the parents by putting these matters on one consistent day per week.

If you should like to take advantage of this protocol for your clients, please be sure to advise the Registrar or the Court when scheduling To Be Spoken to Dates, Place of Safety Hearings, Conferences and Motions.

Please note that this initiative is being introduced as a pilot project at this time.
