Correction of court order

Practice approved by Justice Shelston.

Moving forward, counsel is advised to proceed with the request to correct an order by filing a 14B motion together with an affidavit general explaining the circumstances. They will also provide a **general order** indicating only the information regarding correction and referring to the original order.

An another scenario would be where counsel wishes to provide the original order for the Judge(who granted the order) to amend or make the correction directly on the original order. In this case counsel would write a letter to the registrar explaining the circumstances and provide the original order to be corrected.
