Compendiums – Family Law and Child Protection Motions
A Compendium containing the documents and evidence <u>essential</u> to the hearing of a long (1 hour or more) or complex motion (e.g. summary judgment) may be served and filed with a Factum. A joint Compendium may be filed with the Respondent's Factum. The filing deadline, as with a Factum, is by 2 PM 2 days prior to the motion.
Normally a Compendium would include: copies of the Notice of Motion, Affidavits or essential portions of Affidavits, Financial Statements, Net Family Property Statements, essential Exhibits and excerpts from any other evidence (e.g. transcripts) that will be referred to when arguing the motion.
