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TGA changes to regulation of Autologous Cell and Tissue Products

The Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) announced in October 2017 that there will be changes to the current loophole that excludes from regulation autologous cellular therapies that are manufactured by a medical practitioner (or by a person under their supervision) for a patient in their care.

The TGA hosted a webinar on 7th June which aimed to explain the forthcoming changes to regulation of autologous human cell and tissue products.
