Core features

Important reason #1 for teams

- Better patient outcomes
- Quadruple Aim

Necessary reason #2

- Much more is known about models of IP care but not team development per se

Beneficial reason #3

- Learn before you unlearn

Early introduction and education for students

Team building for practitioners



HEALTH CARE
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Broad Systems Framework

Important when making changes → one area of change leads to other (forced, desired) areas

- changes in training
- service delivery

Interrelationships of educational systems and different types of healthcare settings/systems

- Understanding and designing sustainable models of integrated care training and service provision
- Competency based educational systems
