Interns in this track will receive excellent clinical training while also gaining intensive clinical research experience with the Center for Integrated Healthcare <<http://www.mirecc.va.gov/cih-visn2/>>. CIH is a VA Center of Excellence focused on improving the integration of mental health care into primary care settings.

We want to get the word out for those interested in gaining more experience in integrated healthcare as both a clinician and researcher. Please share with any psychology doctoral students who may be interested. This is a unique opportunity and a wonderful training experience. The intern spends half time doing psychotherapy and assessment in outpatient mental health, and half time doing clinical work and research in integrated primary care, which may include serving as an interventionist in ongoing clinical trials and writing up manuscripts.
