

2019-2020 Doctoral Internship in Medical Family Therapy
at the
Via Christi Family Medicine Residency

Position Description:

Applicants interested in a comprehensive training experience integrated within a diverse, primary care setting are strongly encouraged to apply for this Medical Family Therapy Internship within the Via Christi Family Medicine Residency. This internship will provide the opportunity to serve the underserved population, through both brief consultation and traditional psychotherapy. In serving the underserved population, the intern will collaborate with 54 Family Medicine residents, attending physicians, social workers, PharmD's, and MFT master's students. In addition to clinical training, the intern will gain experience creating and disseminating a Behavioral Health curriculum, provide direct supervision to the MFT master's students, and complete a research study. This is a 12 month program for a full-time Behavioral Science Clinician-Educator. Start date June/July 2019.

Responsibilities:

Clinical: 60%

- Integrated care-Three half days per week.
- Traditional psychotherapy-Three half days per week.

Teaching: 15%

- Share in creation/instruction of Behavioral Health curriculum to Family Medicine residents.
- Supervise Medical Family Therapy interns.

Research: 20%

- Assist with planning, data collection, analysis, and scholarly writing of collaborative research projects.
- Three hours per week specifically dedicated to completion of dissertation.

Admin: 5%

- Manage mental health referrals and perform other administrative tasks.

Requirements:

- Currently enrolled in Marriage and Family Therapy or Medical Family Therapy doctoral program.
- All PhD prerequisite coursework completed by time of the internship start dated.
- Must have passed the national MFT exam.
- Acquired Marriage and Family Therapist License in state of Kansas (provisional).

Salary:

- \$33,000

- Benefits Include: Medical Insurance Plan and \$1,500 CME.
