IG highlights our partnership working for 2022. Including our research programme run with IRG. Our presence and CILIP 2022 was noted as was our best presented SIG stand where we networked with members over the 2 days.

Legislation and Strategy

IG goes on to note The Health and Care Bill passed in April 2022, and the first women's health strategy was published in July. Noting a significant year in health legislation and strategy.

Health Information and Libraries Journal (HILJ)

The impact factor for our academic journal (HILJ) increased to 3.220 in 2022. Ranking the journal at 32/64 in the Information and Science and Library Category. We send heartfelt thanks to Maria Grant our editor in chief and the editorial advisory board who work really hard to make sure our journal is successful. Our virtual issue in 2022 was dedicated to our 75th anniversary.

Core Collection and other publications

We published the Medical Core Collection in 2022 but are still working on the revision of the Nursing and Midwifery Core Collection. IG notes this sentence to be amended in the annual report for accuracy.

We continue to work with Health Education England (HEE) now NHS England Knowledge and Library Services to improve Health Library & Information Services Directory (HLISD).

Activities

We have 1307 members in 2022. We continue to work with CILIP to increase our membership

In August we welcomed to Cheryl Francis as our bursary and awards lead. We have a full programme in place for that going forward.

Marketing and promotion on going, important way to ensure we continue to reach new and potential members. IG call for anyone to submit to our monthly news bulletin and newsletter.

Our CPD panel is always busy carrying out surveys asking what you want and then providing the study sessions you need. We continue to make our sessions free to the end user as much as possible with the exception of the annual conference

We are working with African Health Libraries to produce a new core collection for sub-Saharan health Libraries. We are working with academic libraries across the region.
