

APPENDIX: GAZETTEER OF HISTORIC PUBLIC LIBRARY BUILDINGS, 1850-1940

The gazetteer in this chapter is based on a database that was originally intended for use as a research tool by the authors of this book and was not conceived as a resource to be made publicly available. However, we quickly realised that this rich source of information deserved to be made more widely available. In addition to the gazetteer below, we are hoping to make the database available on a website.

The research for the gazetteer and database was carried out over the course of 4 years and we have found information on over 950 existing buildings, of which more than two thirds are still in library use. The gazetteer also includes details of almost 150 demolished buildings.

The database was composed of tables for existing library buildings (including those no longer in library use) and demolished library buildings. Within the tables a separate record for each individual library building was created, with each record made up of over 40 fields. The database fields used were largely based on those recommended by Antonia Bunch in a report by Elizabeth Quarmby-Lawrence, *Researching the Fabric and Fittings of the Historic Library in the British Isles: Problems and the Way Forward*,¹ which was commissioned by the Library History Group of the then Library Association in 2002.

Fewer fields were used in the table for demolished buildings with the addition of fields for the date of and reason for the demolition or destruction of the building.

The database contains a number of records for libraries that were opened after 1940 (the closing date for the period under consideration in this book). These were all libraries that were planned and, in most cases, already under construction prior to 1940 but were interrupted by wartime restrictions on building and, in some cases, were put to alternative uses during the war.

In the compilation of the gazetteer, we have refined the number of fields to a minimum for the identification of the building and to give an indication of where further information may be found.

Appendix

The Gazetteer is organised by town or city name, with buildings in London organised by (current) London borough.

The order for each entry is as follows: library name, current name and/or use if not a library in brackets, other and former names in italics, philanthropist(s), architect(s), year of library's opening (if library opened in a pre-existing building the building's date appears first in brackets), dates of extensions or additions, listing status, principal architectural and library-related bibliographical references. Demolished or destroyed buildings are included in the gazetteer and appear in italic type. Where known the date and reason for demolition or destruction are given.

The listing system is different in England, Wales and Scotland. In England and Wales grades I and II* are used to denote buildings of exceptional and important significance and grade II for buildings of special architectural interest. Scotland uses the grades A, B and C (Statutory). A is roughly equivalent to I and II*, B is roughly equivalent to II and C is used primarily for the listing of buildings for group value.
