NIELSEN BOOK

Nielsen Book was first established in 1858 when Joseph Whitaker founded The Bookseller magazine. The early issues included a listing of publications each month compiled from 129 publishers including Cambridge University Press, Chambers, Hatchard, Macmillan & Co, John Murray, Oxford University Press and Routledge. The data elements listed included price, publisher, author and a brief description of the book.


Since then the number of publishers and elements we gather has grown exponentially but the principle remains the same: to disseminate bibliographic data to the industry to aid the discovery and purchase of books.

As well as our Discovery services, we also have a long and established role within the book supply chain and measure book sales in 11 territories around the world. We are extremely proud to run the ISBN and SAN Agencies for the UK & Ireland and a number of Nielsen Book employees play key roles in the development and preservation of international industry standards such as THEMA, working closely with organisations such as BIC and EDItEUR. HOW WE GATHER BIBLIOGRAPHIC DATA



Nielsen Book collects data for English-language books, including audio and ebooks, from publishers in 93 countries worldwide. The data is gathered from over 60,000 publishers and suppliers worldwide via electronic data feeds and our online title editing service. We also work with a number of data partners in the US to ensure comprehensive coverage.

THE COUNTRIES FROM WHICH NIELSEN BOOK GATHERS METADATA



The data provided is gathered to create unique, timely, up-to-date records and we currently list over 44m titles on our database. Below is the number of titles listed on our database for each territory.

OUR BIBLIOGRAPHIC DATA

The level of detail we hold for each title depends on what each publisher provides to us but we strive to encourage all publishers to adhere to the BIC Basic standard and indeed our recent research shows that titles meeting that standard enjoy double the average sales of books that don't.






WHO USES OUR DATA

DATA FEED: WEB SERVICE API

Our Web Service API allows you to collect only the data you need at the point when you need it. It means that you can request data for a single ISBN or a whole data set when you want it, secure in the knowledge that the data you download is as up-to-date as it can be.

The data is delivered in an XML format using SOAP or REST web service protocols so it can be used to support existing websites.

You can also make ISBN requests via our FTP site throughout your 12 month subscription.




