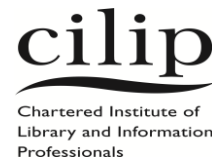

Register of Interests for Trustees and the Office of the President



-
1. Trustees of CILIP and members of the Presidential Team have an obligation to act in the best interests of CILIP. This Register of Interests is provided as part of CILIP's Conflict of Interests policy and as a companion document to the Code of Practice for CILIP Trustees and the Trustee's declaration. Trustees should remind themselves of the provisions of both of these documents before filling in the Register of Interests.
 2. Trustees of CILIP and members of the Presidential Team should not normally receive any form of payment from CILIP except for expenses incurred in undertaking CILIP duties. However Clause 3 of the Royal Charter allows Trustee/Members of the Presidential Team to draw royalties as a Facet author or provide expert advice to CILIP. Clause 3 is printed as an addendum to the Conflict of Interests Policy.
 3. Trustees of CILIP and members of the Presidential Team are also advised that in accordance with a decision of Council at its meeting in April 2004 the Register will be made available on the members only section of the CILIP website. It will also be accessible to members of CILIP staff and will be made available if requested to CILIP's auditors and representatives of the Charity Commission. Your signature on your Register entry indicates acceptance of this. Entries on the Register are personal data and covered by the provisions of the Data Protection Act 1998.
 4. Trustees of CILIP and members of the Presidential Team should ensure that they keep their entry in the Register up to date. Changes should be notified to Ayca Ilcen (ayca.ilcen@cilip.org.uk).
 5. In the interests of transparency and accountability members of the Senior Management Team are also asked to provide an entry in the Register.
