Initial Report: March 31, 2012

Report Update: August 5, 2012
(with data reflective of membership through June 30, 2012)

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1. Introduction

This updated report is based on data obtained on October 6, 2011, March 1, 2012 and June 30, 2012 from the Society for Cinema and Media Studies website as submitted by the current membership as of those dates. As the first report generated in this manner, it is a necessarily incomplete yet a representative indication of the current profile of SCMS membership.

Sections 2 through 7 detail information about the general membership, including membership by nationality, job title, gender, membership in Special Interest Groups and Caucuses, information on teaching, and members' current terminal degree information. While data on membership by nationality and job title is based on categories determined by the SCMS website (such as "International Member" or "Associate Professor"), data on gender and membership in Special Interest Groups and Caucuses is based on the selection of membership who self-reported their gender and/or have opted to join a SIG or Caucus. Sections 6 and 7, which include data on teaching and degree granting institutions, are also based on information reported by a selection of current members. In the case of the reports on teaching in Section 6, the percentage of members reporting has been noted. For terminal degree information, listings of degree granting institutions have been collated in descending order, beginning with the institutions with the greatest number of graduates for that degree group. It should be noted that this section only lists terminal degrees (so a member with a PhD from one institution will be listed under PhD and their MA or BA information is not included).

Section 8 is comprised of reports on attendance at the 2011 and 2012 SCMS annual conferences delineated by nationality, job title, and gender. Due to a singular issue in data collection, these reports are organized by 2011-2012 membership information rather than 2010-2011 (e.g. a member who was a graduate student in March 2011 but is now a faculty member would be listed as an assistant professor in this section). As in Section 4, gender is again categorized according to self-reporting by current members.

Hence, the June 2012 numbers reflect *only* those members who chose to self-report instead self-reporting members and members whose gender information was gathered from an old version of the database.
