**Regis' Jeanne Gilbert receives Colorado Association of School Personnel Administrators Sandra Shreve Award**

**Breckenridge, Colorado** - The Colorado Association of School Executives (CASE) recognized the significant contributions of Jeanne Gilbert, an Assistant Professor of Student Teacher Services at Regis University, at its 44th Annual Education Leadership Convention in Breckenridge.

Gilbert received the Sandra Shreve award, which recognizes her outstanding professional contribution and service to CASE and to the Colorado Association of School Personnel Administrators (CASPA) on a national level.

Gilbert has worked in education for 38 years as a principal, director of human resources and professor.

"Change is coming quickly, and we need to be open to ideas of doing our work in a completely different manner than we have known," Gilbert said.

According to the education leader, one of the biggest challenges facing education leaders today is "to be optimistic for the future of our mission to educate children even in the face of public criticism, limited resources and political agendas."

Sandra Shreve is a well-known education champion, who worked as a teacher and administrator in the Aurora Public Schools. She was the Chair of the Board of Directors of the Colorado's Women's Hall of Fame and the President for the League of Women Voters of Denver.
