**Re:** Fiscal Year 2027 Comparative Chart

On April 3, the Administration released the details of its budget proposal for Fiscal Year (FY) 2027. Below is a comparative chart for key programs impacting children and families. For the U.S. Department of Education (ED), the chart includes final figures for FY 2025 that were made publicly available through the budget documents, demonstrating previously undisclosed cuts to certain programs.
