- Whereas:** Dr. Richard A. Meserve served as Chairman of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission from October 1999 to March 2003;
- Whereas:** As NRC Chairman, Dr. Meserve provided the Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors, Inc. (CRCPD) significant opportunities to partner with NRC in our mutual regulatory missions;
- Whereas:** His legal experience has enhanced the body of radiation law;

- Whereas:** He devoted his legal practice to technical issues arising in environmental and toxic tort litigation, counseling scientific societies and high-tech companies, and nuclear licensing;
