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Board of Directors Resolution

- Relating to: Response of Radiation Control Programs to COVID-19 Pandemic
- Whereas: The World Health Organization (WHO) has declared COVID-19 coronavirus a global pandemic.
- Whereas: COVID-19 community spread has been identified in the United States.
- Whereas: Radiation Control Program personnel routinely interface with health care facilities and other critical infrastructure.
- Whereas: Radiation Control Program personnel provide vital emergency response functions.
- Whereas: Radiation Control Program inspection and enforcement is risk informed.
- Whereas: The Constitution of the CRCPD includes the objectives:
- To exercise leadership with radiation control professionals and consumers in radiation control development and action
 - To encourage and promote cooperative enforcement programs with federal agencies and between related enforcement agencies within each state
 - To encourage the interchange of experience among radiation control programs
 - To collect and make accessible to the membership of the CRCPD such information and data as might be of assistance to them in the proper fulfillment of their duties.
- Now be it resolved: State and local radiation control programs should implement risk-based graded measures to protect radiation control program staff, limit transmission of COVID-19, ensure sustainability of radiation emergency response functions, and minimize disruption and distraction of critical healthcare services and workers.
- Be it further resolved: CRCPD shall coordinate with federal partners and professional organizations in the development by and communication of consensus guidance to members.
