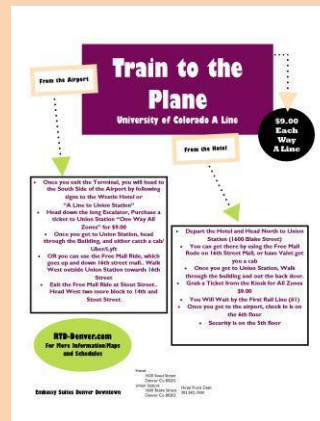

TRAINING AND FEES

The following training will be held in conjunction with the NORM IX International Symposium:

Cradle to Grave Practical Workshop – Sunday, September 22, 2019, 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. This one-day real-world course managing NORM from identification to final disposition will address practical and logical methods in managing NORM contaminated equipment and waste. **Registration fee: \$350**

EPA Risk Assessment Overview - Sunday, September 22, 2019, 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. This full-day advanced course focuses on specific technical and regulatory issues that Remedial Project Managers (RPMs) and On-scene Coordinators (OSCs) address when managing Superfund sites that have a risk assessment conducted for radioactive contaminants. **There is no registration fee for this course.**

IAEA Safety Standards on NORM - Wednesday, September 25, 2019, 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 (Noon). This session will provide information on relevant safety standards applicable to industrial activities involving NORM and present key safety issues in terms of policy regulatory and operational aspects. **There is no registration fee for this course.**

CRCPD Workshop on NORM in Oil and Gas Sector - Wednesday, September 25, 2019, 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. Join CRCPD, state, local, national and international organizations to identify priority issues related to the handling and disposal of TENORM generated during some industrial processes. Discuss measures that can be taken to improve protection of workers and members of the public. This workshop is limited to 50 attendees. **There is no registration fee for this workshop.**
