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Charges:

1. Continuously seek and validate new resources for the CRCPD Rad/Nuc Emergency Toolbox including resources for training CRCPD members in radiological and nuclear emergency response and recovery, and incorporate them into the Rad/Nuc Emergency Toolbox and the ROSS Toolkit in RadResponder.
- 2.* Work with the Director Members of the CRCPD to help them understand their role in identifying, training, and qualifying ROSS candidates in their jurisdictions.
- 3.* Encourage the incorporation of ROSS into state and local radiological and nuclear emergency plans and planning, training and exercise activities including plume and ingestion phase exercises at nuclear power plants are among ideas being considered.
- 4.* Develop methods to maintain the competency of ROSS leveraging content from ROSS continuing Education and ROSS Ready University curriculum.
5. Work with FEMA CBRN, CRCPD leadership and the Office of the Executive Director to develop a concept of operations (CONOPS) for ROSS cadre management and competency maintenance to include funding for annual ROSS refresher training and ROSS participation in exercises.
