SR-AA Suggested Regulations - Part AA: Non-ionizing Radiation

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Charges:

1. Revise the suggested state regulation to:
 - Harmonize with amendments to the FDA radiation safety performance standard for laser products. FDA's regulation effectively adopts the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) laser safety standard in recognition that it better addresses current technology and provides equivalent or improved product safety.
 - Split medical use of non-ionizing radiation and industrial use of non-ionizing radiation two sections.
 - Include cosmetic use of non-ionizing radiation as a medical use, including microwave and RF used for medical cosmetic treatments that may cause patient burns. [G1 – O2, O4]
2. Identify states with non-ionizing testing and/or inspection programs to determine training needs and address implementation issues (i.e., report listing state programs, questionnaire/poll results of training needs) [G1 – O3, O4]
3. Develop and/or identify educational training resources to facilitate transition to new performance requirements (i.e., list or public/private resources available) [G1 – O3, O4]
