

Layered Grannies Homework

Using smooth, light-colored yarn worsted weight yarn or dk-weight yarn. For best results, choose several colors that coordinate with each other and can be used together. You'll be much happier if you are making pretty grannies!

Granny Square

The instructions here are for a one-color granny, but feel free to adapt this to use as many colors as you like. Make one.

Ch 4, join with slip st to form ring, or begin with Magic Circle/sliding loop.

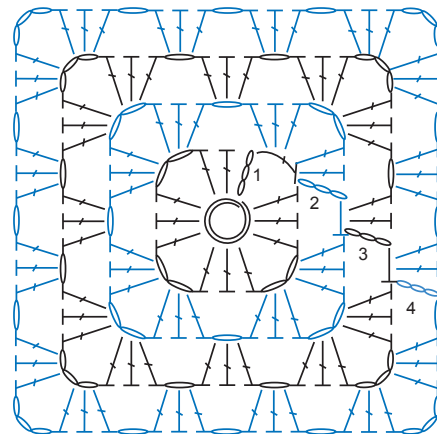
Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), 2 dc in ring, *ch 2, 3 dc in ring; rep from * two more times; join with dc to 3rd ch of ch-5-12 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in space formed by joining dc, *ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next space; rep from * around, ending join with hdc in top of ch-3.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in same space, *ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next space**, ch 1, 3 dc in next space; rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join with hdc in top of ch-3.

Rnd 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same space, *ch 1, 3 dc in next space, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next space, ch 1**, 3 dc in next space; rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join with slip st in top of ch-3. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.



Mesh Square

Make one in a single color.

Ch 4, join with slip st to form a ring, or begin with Magic Circle/sliding loop.

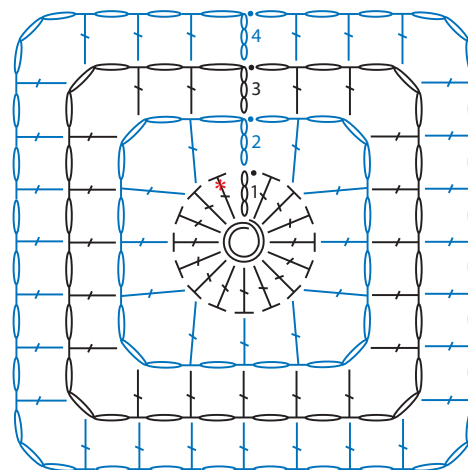
Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 15 dc in ring, join with slip st to top of ch-3-16 dc. Place marker in second dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1), skip 1 dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc, *dc in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc; rep from * around, join with slip st to 3rd ch of ch-4.

Rnd 3: Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1), dc in next dc, *ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next space**, (ch 1, dc in next dc) three times; rep from * around, ending last rep at **, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, join with slip st to 3rd ch of ch-4.

Rnd 4: Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1), *(dc in next dc, ch 1) two times, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next space**, (ch 1, dc in next dc) three times, ch 1; rep from * around, ending last rep at **, (ch 1, dc in next dc) two times, ch 1, join with slip st to 3rd ch of ch-4. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

beg: beginning

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

rep: repeat

rnd(s): round(s)

st(s): stitch(es)

Mesh Hexagon

Make one in a single color.

Ch 4, join with slip st to form a ring, or begin with Magic Circle/sliding loop.

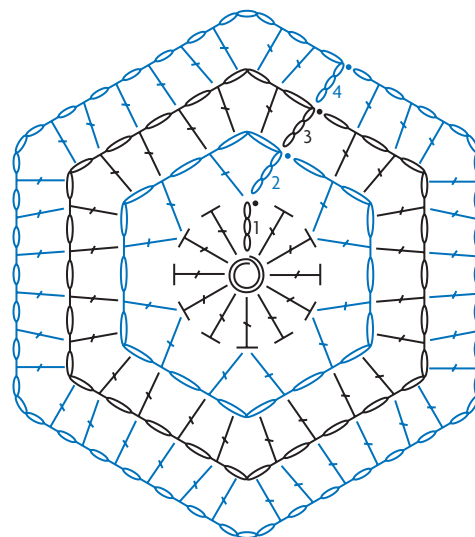
Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), 11 dc in ring, join with slip st in top of ch-3 – 12 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 5 (counts as dc and ch 2), dc in same dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc, *(dc, ch 2, dc) in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc; rep from * around, join with slip st to 3rd ch of ch-5.

Rnd 3: Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1), *(dc, ch 2, dc) in next space**, ch 1, (dc in next dc, ch 1) two times; rep from * around, ending last rep at **, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, join with slip st to 3rd ch of ch-4.

Rnd 4: Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1), dc in next dc, *ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next space**, (ch 1, dc in next dc) four times, ch 1; rep from * around, ending last rep at **, (ch 1, dc in next dc) two times, ch 1, join with slip st to 3rd ch of ch-4. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.



Mesh Circle

Make one in a single color.

V-st: (Dc, ch 1, dc) in 1 stitch.

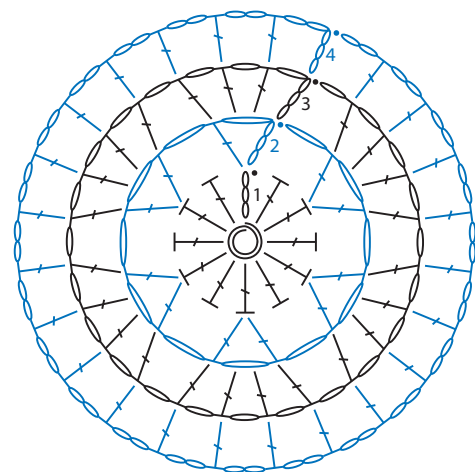
Ch 4, join with slip st to form a ring, or begin with Magic Circle/sliding loop.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), 11 dc in ring, join with slip st in top of ch-3 – 12 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 4, dc in same st (counts as V-st), ch 1, skip 1 dc, *V-st in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc; rep from * around, join with slip st to 3rd ch of ch-4.

Rnd 3: Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1), *(dc, ch 1) two times in next ch-space**, (dc, ch 1) in next 2 dc; rep from * around, ending last rep at **, dc in next dc, ch 1, join with slip st to 3rd ch of ch-4.

Rnd 4: Ch 5 (counts as dc and ch 2), *dc in next dc, ch 2; rep from * around, join with slip st to 3rd ch of ch-5; drop loop from hook. Do not fasten off.



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
