

Homework for **No Sew Area**

Make two squares in colour 1 and two squares in colour 2

Ch-5, Join with a slip stitch into the first ch to form
a ring/circle

Round 1: ch 3(counts as 1st dc)23 dc into the ring. JWSS into the top of the 3 ch –24 dc

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in the same place as the ch 1[ch-5, sk 1 dc, sc in the next st] 11 times, ch 2, 1 dc in the first sc worked in the round. *This acts as a ch-5 loop and has you in the correct position to begin the next round.*—12 x ch-5 loops

Round 3: (ch-5, sc in the next ch-5 loop) 11 times, 2 ch, 1 dc in the top of the dc in the last round.--12 x ch-5 loops

Round 4: Ch-5, sc in the next ch-5 loop, ch 10, sc in the next ch-5 loop[(ch-5, sc in the next ch-5 loop)twice, ch 10, sc in the next ch-5 loop] 3 times, ch 2, 1 dc in the top of the dc in the last round.--8 ch-5 loops & 4 ch-10 loops. Fasten off. Leave a 12 tail.

Make 3 sets of 2 as follows:

Ch 18, dc in the 4th ch from hook, dc in each ch across—16 dc

Row 2: Ch 1(this is not counted as a stitch), 1 dc in each st across. Turn.—16 dc

Repeat row 2 until 8 rows have been worked.
