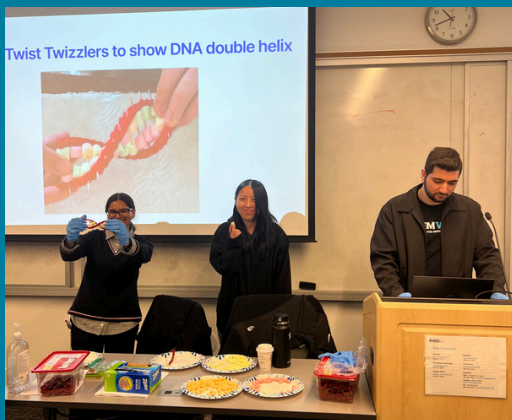


Although not all volunteered, many KGI CSHP members were present on January 25th such as former president Dharam Amin (P4)

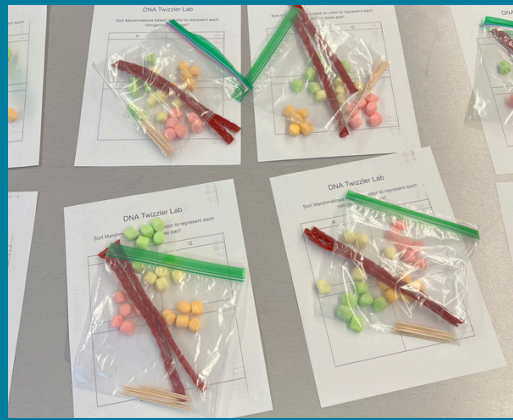


STEMWISE Keck Graduate Institute

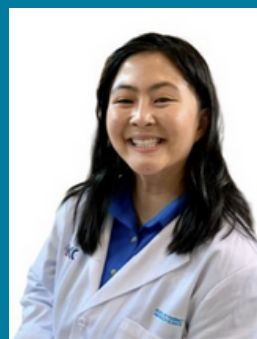

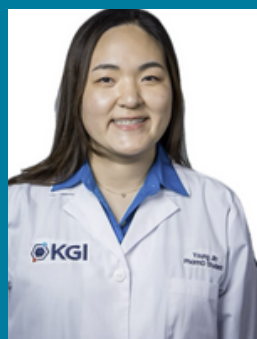
