Stop The Bleed



MBKU-CSHP chapter was honored to organize and host Stop the Bleed for students of pharmacy, optometry and PA programs. Colleagues came to learn how to stop life-threatening bleeding.

The training included hands-on practice such as using tourniquets and hemostatic dressings that was led by our professor, Dr. Kayvan Moussavi, PharmD, BCCCP. The focus of this program is to teach healthcare professionals how to recognize life threatening bleeds and respond appropriately. Our students are now trained to assist with work-related injuries, mass shootings, home injuries, motor vehicle crashes, and bombings. From this, students learned the ABCs of Bleeding: Alert, Bleeding, and Compress.

CSHP x MCPHS Industry Fellows

In October, MBKU student pharmacists had opportunities to learn more about biopharmaceutical industry fellowships with Dr. Joshua Liu and Dr. Christopher Nguyen via Zoom. MCPHS fellowship network spans across 11 companies with over 100 fellows. Mission Hospital Flu Clinic

During the period of September 26 to October 21 2022, MBKU student pharmacists had an opportunity to participate in annual caregiver flu vaccines clinics in Mission Hospital, Mission Viejo. 19 student pharmacists signed up for a 4-hour morning shift of 2 volunteers per time. In addition to administering influenza vaccines to caregivers who worked at Mission Hospital, student pharmacists had experienced how to set up stations, prepare supplies, stock and promote immunizations to caregivers. Dr. Simon Han, Director of Pharmacy, gave the volunteers a hospital tour, also answered questions and advised students for better future planning after graduation. This was the first time MBKU students had a chance to collaborate with Mission Hospital for a health fair event. We are looking forward to more opportunities in the following years.

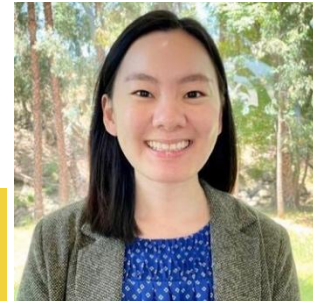

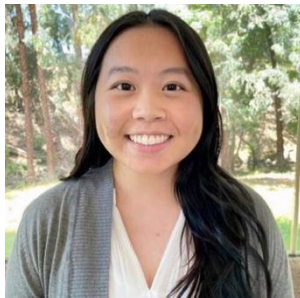
